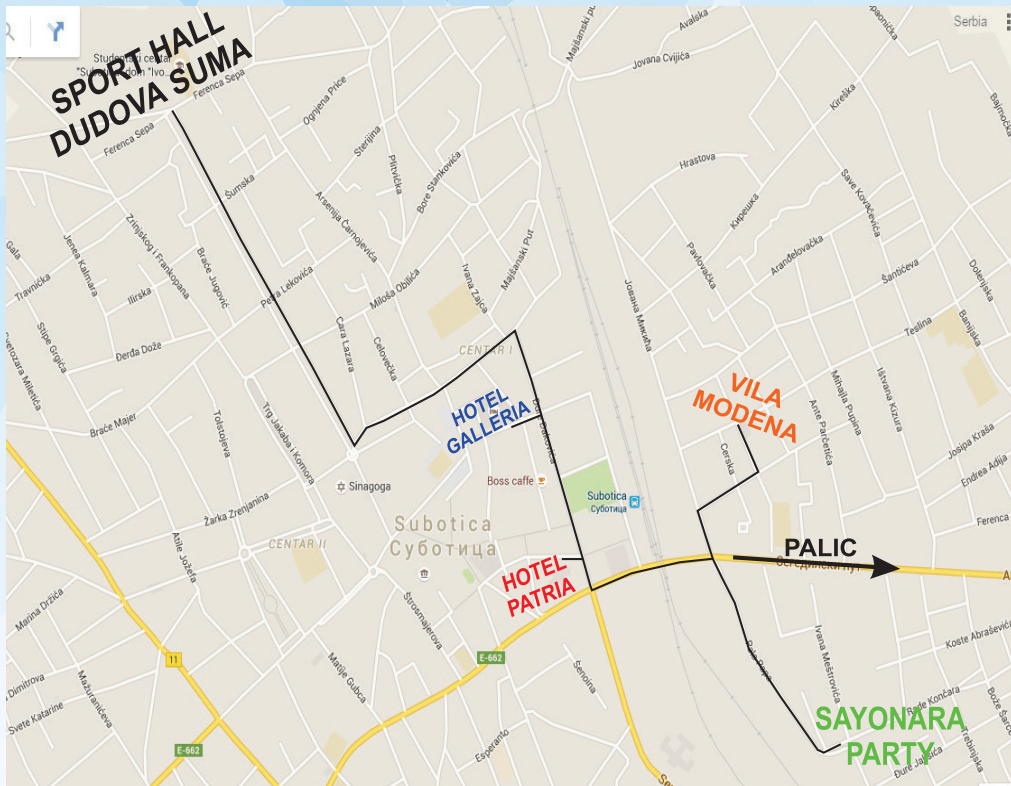

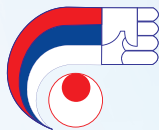
A total of 152 clubs across Serbia was registered in 2015.
